Carers Assessments

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Coping with Caring

Join us for this session to find out about normal ageing versus not normal ageing. We will explore the impact of changing sensory awareness and processing as dementia progresses.

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
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We have the following training and information sessions planned to support carers in their caring role.

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


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Understanding Obsessive Compulsive Disorder Tuesday 14th December (6pm-8pm) Face to face session at Linskill Centre in North Shields
