Overall Role

- Review and help to develop marketing resources to reach young carers of all ages.
- Maximise local and national media opportunities to raise the profile of young carers.
- Influence local and national policy affecting young carers.

Discussions

How can we reach people who have no support?

- NTCC offer more assemblies and awareness-raising events in schools.
- Provide opportunities for carers to have a voice
- Record sessions so carers can watch at a later date
- Do not permanently close a call, touch-base on an ad-hoc basis, allow access post-intervention, and other services provide 2 years.
- School led groups for Young Carers during lesson time rather than lunch or free time.

What should carers' support look like in 2026?

- Support in schools: 2-week check-ins
- provide a Chat Bot through CHATGPT
- Support to plan time between parents and carers for 121 time.
- Widen awareness before school
- Advertising what is available for carers through little adverts on phones
- Transportation support
- NTCC presence at parent evenings, open days, careers days: Primary, Secondary and Higher Education,

What do carers want from our centre?

- Full day trips
- Transport support - funds/passes
- Annual check-in from a Family Support Worker
- Young Adult Carer groups - not always on the same day of the week to support attendance.
- Online sessions
- Recorded sessions
- Financial support and extra help for those with a high caring role who cannot leave their home due to caring.
